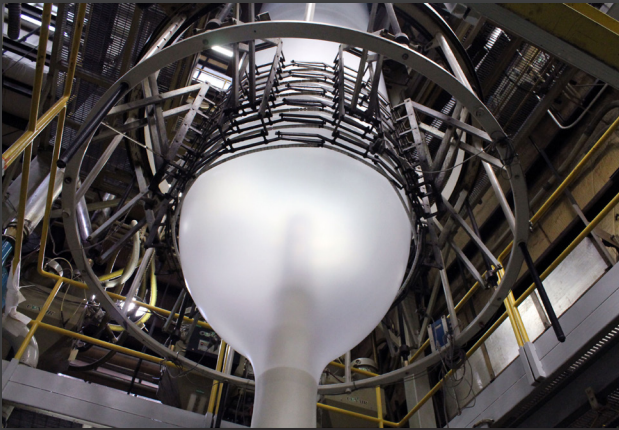

BRIEF COMPANY HISTORY

- 1969** - Petoskey Plastics, Inc. was founded in Petoskey, MI.
- 1975** - Began extruding own film.
- 1978** - Built new Petoskey plant and increased production. Began recycling processes.
- 1987** - Obtained a patent for a Slip-N-Grip® polyethylene disposable seat cover.
- 1992** - Began offering closed-loop recycling for its customers.
- 1997** - Obtained ISO Certification.
- 1999** - Bought the assets of a polyethylene film extrusion plant in Morristown, TN.
- 2006** - Purchased a former garage door factory in Hartford City, IN.
- 2007** - Opened a new corporate headquarters in downtown Petoskey. Later that year, new Hartford City recycling plant, converting the building to 330,000 sq. ft.
- 2009** - Obtained SCS Global certification for post-consumer recycled polyethylene resin.
- 2013** - Added blown film manufacturing and converting lines to Hartford City.
- 2015** - Petoskey Plastics reused more than 30 million pounds of recycled plastic.
- 2016** - Developed the Petoskey Plastics Sustainability Scorecard program.
- 2018** - 40th Anniversary of Recycling. New \$8 million wash line installed. Morristown plant expansion.
- 2019** - 50th Anniversary of Petoskey Plastics.
- 2020** - Began manufacturing of Non-Surgical Protection Gowns in response to COVID-19.
- 2021** - \$30 million facility opens in McKinney, TX.
- 2023** - No Objection Letter (NOL) issued by FDA for Food-Contact PCR-LLDPE GreenPE® resin.

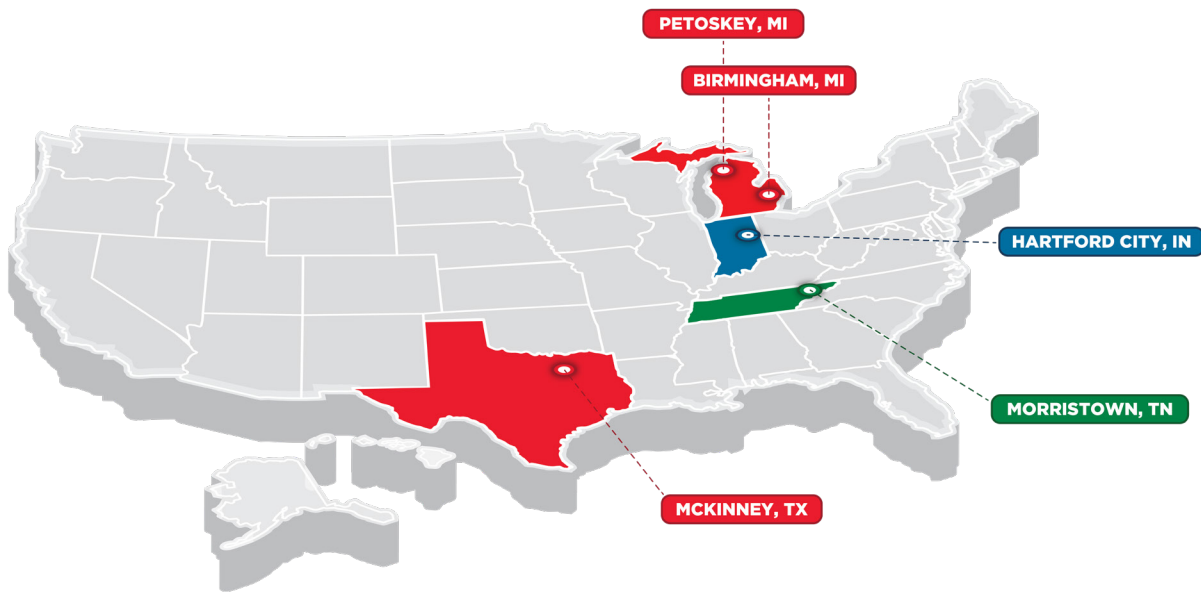
